Date	City	Travel itinerary	Meal
Day1 SUN	Seoul Gongju Jeonju	Meet your guide at 8:00 am in front of Donghwa Duty Free Shop Building, Gwanghwamun Intersection, Seoul. From there, travel to Gongju (130 km/1 hr 30 min) to explore the history of the Baekje Dynasty and visit the UNESCO-listed Tomb of King Muryeong . Continue to Gongsanseong Fortress , a Baekje Period mountain castle also recognized by UNESCO. Then, transfer to Jeonju (80 km/1 hr) to experience Jeonju Hanok Village , home to around 700 traditional Korean houses. Finally, check into your hotel in Jeonju and enjoy some leisure time. Hotel: Best Western Plus Jeonju Hotel or similar (4-star)	B:X L:X D:X
Day2 MON	Jeonju Gwangju Suncheon Yeosu	Start your day with breakfast before heading to Gwangju, a 1 hour 30-minute drive (100 km) known for its role in the modern democratic movement. Explore the May 18th National Cemetery , linked to the Gwangju Democratization movement. Then, travel to Suncheon, a 1-hour drive (100 km), to visit Suncheon Bay National Garden . Finally, head to Yeosu, a romantic coastal city just 38 km away (40 min), and explore Yi Sun-shin Plaza before checking into your hotel. Hotel: Ramada Plaza by Wyndham Yeosu or similar (4-star)	B:O L:X D:X
Day3 TUE	Yeosu Jinju Busan Gyeongju	After breakfast, visit Jinjuseong Fortress which is historically linked to Japanese invasion in 1592, then travel to Busan. Arrive at Gimhae domestic airport and depart from there. Pickup at Toyoko Inn hotel 1, Busan Station at 13:00. Explore Jagalchi Market , BIFF Square , and Haeundae Beach . Lastly visit Dongbaek Park before transferring to Gyeongju and checking to hotel. Hotel: Commodore Hotel Gyeongju or similar (4-star)	B:O L:X D:X
Day4 WED	Gyeongju Andong Pyeong-chang	After breakfast, visit the UNESCO-listed Seokguram Grotto and Bulguksa Buddhist Temple , known for their beauty and historical significance. Then, travel to Andong (170 km/2 hr 30 min) to explore the UNESCO-listed Andong Hahoe Village , famous for its preservation of Joseon Dynasty architecture. Next, journey to Pyeongchang (234 km/2 hr 30 min), the host city of the 2018 Winter Olympics. Then checking into your hotel. Hotel: RAMADA Hotel PyeongChang or similar (4-star)	B:O L:X D:X
Day5 THU	Pyeong-chang Mt.Sorak Seoul	Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before embarking on a tour of the 2018 Winter Olympic Games venues . Then, head to Sokcho, just a 1 hour 30-minute drive (100 km) away. Along the way, if time allows , stop by Gangneung Hangho beach and the BTS Bus station , known for its association with the album jacket "You Never Walk Alone". Upon arrival in Sokcho, visit the UNESCO Biosphere Zone, Seoraksan National Park, renowned for its stunning landscapes and rare species. Optionally, take a cable car to Gwongeumseong Fortress (USD 20 per person) . Finally, travel back to Seoul, approximately a 3 hour 30-minute drive (195 km), with an estimated arrival time at The Donghwa Duty Free Shop Building around 17:00. During peak season in October, buses are restricted from entering Seoraksan National Park. Parking will be at C District Square with a 3.6 km walk to the entrance. Please be aware we may not visit the park during this tour.	B:O L:X D:X
